Club Update – 6th June

Following last week's update from the Government, the LTA has now released further guidance on the re-opening of tennis clubs.

From 1st June, the club can now confirm:

- OUTDOOR COURTS are now available for both singles and doubles play. <u>PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ THE NEW GUIDELINES AS LISTED IN THE DOCUMENT BELOW.</u>
- INDOOR CENTRE remains temporarily closed.
- CLUBHOUSE remains temporarily closed, no access permitted.
- SMALL GROUP COACHING can also take place with no more than six people (including the coach) on a court at one time. Please contact Josh for more details joshgook@jgtennis.co.uk
- FULL COACHING PROGRAMME will not re-commence at this present time. However, our coaches continue to be available for individuals or small group coaching (no more than 5 people).
- VISITOR FEES of £5 per visitor MUST be paid by BACS transfer (Account number 36796268, Sort code 309089) or place in the Clubhouse post box in a named envelope.

These latest guidelines are hopefully another step to eventually re-opening the whole tennis facility but everyone needs to 'Stay Alert' to ensure the latest Government guidelines are met. Updated posters have been displayed at the club, please take a few minutes to read these and make sure you observe the original guidelines as set out in the member's communication on 12th May, this is also published on www.altc.net/news

Remember, members and visitors should not congregate on or around the courts or patio before and after play. You must also continue to bring and use your own hand sanitiser before and after play.

Thank you to all members who have observed the guidelines whilst visiting the club but if you notice any visitors not adhering to these rules please let a committee member know.

We are conscious there is a lot of information to absorb but we do hope you see this is in the best interests of all of us. By following these guidelines it will help to keep the courts open but if they are not adhered to the Club will be forced to close again.
