A few reminders are:

- Social distancing please respect others and keep your distance.
- Handwashing and sanitising please wash your hands frequently and use hand sanitiser.
- **COVID symptoms or a positive test** If you or a family member has visited the club and then become unwell with COVID symptoms or receive a positive test, please contact the Club via <u>info@altc.net</u>
- NHS Test and Trace whilst it is no longer a legal requirement to collect contact details, by doing so will help to reduce the spread of the virus. As a Club we want to continue to support this so the NHS QR code posters will still be available throughout the site for visitors to check in. The Member's Club Night register will also continue to be taken.
- **Ventilation** if you are socialising in the clubhouse, please ensure doors and windows are opened. But please remember to close them when you leave.
- Face coverings whilst no longer required by law, the Government expects and recommends individuals should continue to wear them in crowded and enclosed areas.
