### Coaching Tip of the month (by Josh)...

Practice the most under practiced shot in Tennis... The Return! How often have you started a match warming up your forehand and backhand, then hitting a few volleys and smashes before hitting 10 or so serves and declaring yourself ready? You have forgotten the second most important shot in the whole game! So many of the top players in the world have a game built on a consistent and aggressive return (think Djokovic, Halep and Rafa) yet at club Tennis we don't give it the attention it deserves. Next time you practice ask your partner to serve for 5-10 minutes and pick a spot on the other side (deep cross court is always a good place to start) and hit 40-50 returns in a row, I can imagine most of you have probably never done this! Next time you play a match make sure you hit some returns before starting (even if it is just 1 or 2 it will help with your rhythm and confidence, particularly if it is a player you haven't faced before which of course means you haven't returned their serve before...). I look forward to seeing you all crushing consistent returns from now on!
